## CONDITIONS

1. Regional Champions are the highest scoring in each event, i.e. Male, Female, Junior.
2. Comp 1 & 2 are the championships which must be shot before 3 & 4. Comps 3 & 4 are additional open events. There will be an aggregate competition (Comp 5 & 6) in each discipline/class for those who enter both championship and open events.
3. All shooting will be conducted to current ISSFRules<sup>3</sup>, except where stated otherwise or limited by facilities. Pistol competitors will shoot two shots/target. It is the shooters responsibility to ensure their equipment conforms to the ISSF rules and regulations.
4. Competitors are required to use Safety Flags as required by ISSF 2013 rules.
5. Disability competitors are welcome. Unsupported (SH1) competitors will shoot in the open classes, supported competitors (SH2) will compete together in class(es) subject to 8 & 9 below.
6. Competitors not declaring an average will be entered into "A" class.
7. The number of competitions, classes, and prize list will depend upon entry at the closing date. See 8 & 9 below.
8. A minimum of three competitors is required to run a class or competition. If there are fewer than three, entrants will be allocated to the nearest appropriate class.
9. Prizes in comps and classes awarded as follows.
  - 1-3 Competitors : 1st place
  - 4-7 Competitors : 1st & 2nd place
  - 8 + Competitors : 1st, 2nd & 3rd place
10. Juniors are those under 21 on 31 Dec 2019. All other ages are taken at this date. In the championship, 'Junior' fee is payable even when there is no separate competition, which entitles entry to relevant senior competition. There will be additional awards for Competitors under 18 years and Under 16 on 31<sup>st</sup> December.
11. Competitors U13 years on 31st Dec, can shoot two-handed (pistol) or supported (rifle) using a flexible or "Belgian" stand – provide your own).
12. Cheques payable to "WMRTSS".
13. **ENTRY FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE**
